HEALTH MINISTRY

WELLNESS MADE EASY: *According to recent tests by Consumers Union, fresh chicken is more contaminated with bacteria today than six years ago. To be safe, make sure no juices from raw poultry come in contact with other foods; wash your hands well after handling, & cook to at least 165 degrees F. *Don't take a pain reliever before or during exercise or sports in hopes of preventing pain and improving performance. A recent editorial in the British Journal of Sports Medicine warned that this misuse could inhibit the body's ability to adapt to challenging workouts and interfere with healing, besides increasing the risk of stomach bleeding. If you feel pain with exercising, your body is telling you to stop for a reason - and you don't want to mask this warning sign.
