**HEALTH MINISTRY**

**WORKSHOP ON CREATIVE RELAXATION & STRESS MANAGEMENT:** Mon., **Aug 16th**, at 7:00 p.m., in the Marian Inn. Parishioner Karen Anne Litecky Melendez (Licensed Professional Counselor & Board Certified Music Therapist) will host an interactive talk on coping with stress. This session will include use of relaxation techniques, using music and art to release stress and to support well being.

**PLAYGROUND PRECAUTIONS:** To a kid, a playground means freedom to run, swing, slide, and jump. Before releasing your child to play, observe these safeguards from The National Safety Council: What your kids wear is a safety factor. Remove hoods or drawstrings that can get caught in play equipment. Teach your child about playground safety - how to be aware and act responsibly around other children & equipment. Make sure your child plays on age appropriate equipment. Guardrails should surround all elevated platforms & be at least 29" high for preschool-age children, and 38" high for school-age children. Inspect equipment for sharp edges & hardware, such as open 'S' hooks and protruding nails & bolts. The ground around play equipment should provide for soft landings: rubber mats or tiles and at least 12" of loose fill, such as sand or pea gravel, spreading at least 6' outward from equipment. Scan play areas for broken glass, nails, and tripping hazards such as exposed concrete footings, tree stumps/roots or rocks. Report maintenance problems to the city or parks department.
